This term, we will be identifying and naming a variety of common animals and classifying them. We will be thinking about the different things they eat and grouping them into carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

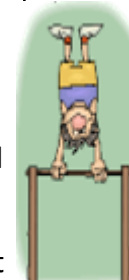


Computing
