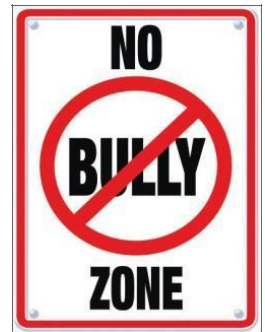

What is Bullying?

This could be name calling, hurting someone or threatening to hurt someone, spreading unpleasant stories about someone, making someone feel lonely.

BULLYING IS NOT

A one-off fight, an argument with a friend, a spur of the moment threat or a spiteful comment.

What will happen if you tell someone?

- A class teacher will investigate and record on an incident form.
- A class teacher will tell Mr McNama, Miss Lloyd, Mrs Beard, Ms White or Mrs Haskey and pass on the copy of the report.
- Mr McNama, Miss Lloyd, Mrs Beard, Ms White or Mrs Haskey will investigate if it happens again.
- Where incidents are proven, all parent/carers will be told and asked to support any action taken by the school.



Cyber Bullying

- Children are not allowed a mobile phone in school.
- Children do not access the internet unsupervised.
- Any school chat rooms are monitored regularly.

DO

- Do tell someone either a teacher, adult or friend.
- Do try and tell the bully to stop.



DON'T

- Don't copy the behaviour of the bully.
- Don't do it back to them.
- Don't join in bullying behaviour.
