Maths

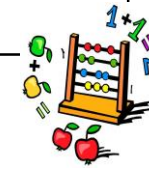
In Maths, pupils will focus on understanding what factors, multiples and primes are.

Fantastic Finale:

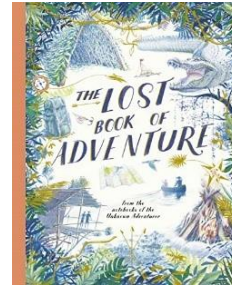
We will present an informative assembly.
