## Understanding the world

We will be talking about our local area and making comparisons. We will follow simple maps and draw our own for others to follow. We will be making links to the 'Little Red' story and her walk through the woods. Also, we will be looking for seasonal changes as Spring arrives.



## RE

We will be learning about the story of Easter and how Christians celebrate this time of year.



## Literacy

In reading, we will be reviewing all our digraphs and learning to read longer words. Some of our new words will end in -ing, -ed, or -es. There will be no new tricky words. In writing, we will be using our phonemes to spell longer words and begin to join sentences with the word 'and'.



## Mathematics

This term, we will be looking at language to describe the position of objects around our environment. Later in the term we will be exploring number bonds to 10. Number bonds to 10 are two numbers added together to make 10 e.g. 5+5, 1+9 and 2+8. We will explore these using lots of fun counting materials.

## PSED

In our circle time sessions, we will be thinking about how to keep our bodies healthy and fit.
