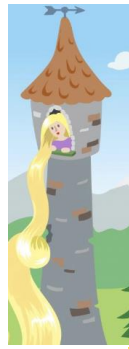


Brilliant Beginning:

English

This term we will be using the text 'Rapunzel' by Bethan Woolvin. To start with, we will look carefully at the story in order to write a traditional tale narrative of our own. We will then use our text as inspiration to write a set of instructions on how to trap a troll.



Maths

This term in maths we will be learning about the numbers 6-9. We will begin to understand that numbers six to nine are made up of 'five and a bit'. We will find these numbers on a number line. We will look at odd and even numbers and understand how they can be partitioned. We will partition numbers in a systematic way.

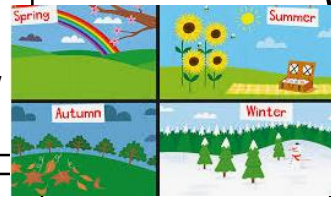


Fantastic Finale:

Science

This term we will be learning about plants and animals in a woodland habitat. We will identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. We will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. We will observe changes across the four seasons, observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

Geography

We will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to physical features, including: forest, hill, river, soil, valley, vegetation. We will name features, including: city, town, house. We will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.



Art

We will use paint and collage to create different wildlife. We will develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space. We will look at the work of different artists and create our own version of the Matisse Snail.



PSHE

This term our Jigsaw Unit is called 'Celebrating Differences'. We will think about how we are different from each other and how this makes us all unique! We will understand the word 'Bullying' and know what to do about it.



Computing

In Computing this term we will be exploring digital art and creating their own digital paintings.



PE

In PE this term we will be looking at gymnastics. We will be learning how to use the apparatus safely.



Music

In music we will be looking at Reggae and hip hop! We will be learning that music is made up of long and short sounds called rhythm and high and low sounds that we call pitch.

RE

In RE this term we will be retelling the Christmas Story. We will be thinking why the gifts given to Jesus might have been meaningful in Bethlehem.
