## Maths

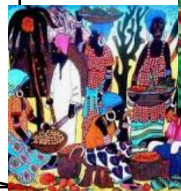

## Fantastic Finale:

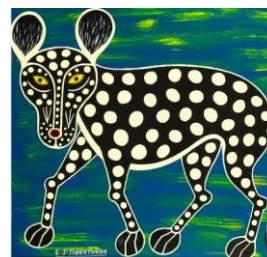
We will be sharing all of our knowledge about the geographical features, animals, art and music of Africa in a parent assembly.

## Art

## Owl Term 4

## PSHE

Using our PSHE scheme, Jigsaw we will be thinking about how we can keep ourselves healthy. The children will be thinking about healthy food and having a healthy relationship with food. They will also talk about making healthy choices and consider the link between good diet and stress.

## RE

In RE this term we will be looking at the key question 'How important to Christians is it that Jesus came back to life after his crucifixion?'. We learn about the events of Easter Sunday and the impact this has on Christians today.

## Computing

We will be exploring how programming is giving a computer a sequence of instructions to follow. The children will learn how to use instructions to create different algorithms to program a floor robot.

## Music

In music this term we will be learning how to recognize different sounds in a piece of music, by understanding the sounds of different instruments.

Key question: How Does Music Teach us about our neighbourhood?

## PE

In PE this term we will be learning about fitness and invasion games. Through a variety of activities we will deepen their understanding of the fundamentals of sporting skills.



## Geography

This term we will be comparing similarities between human and physical geography in Bristol and in Africa.

We will be using world maps, atlases and globes to locate countries, continents and oceans.

We will be talking like a geographer using vocabulary such as human features, physical features, forest, ocean, city, farm, house, factory and weather.
