

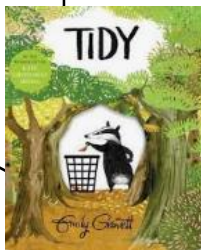
Brilliant Beginning:

Maths

We will add and subtract 2 digit numbers from 2 digit numbers and complete missing number problems. We will complete word problems where we have to figure out if it is asking us to add or subtract.

We will educate the community of the importance of recycling and looking after our environment. We will do this by sharing information posters. We will also be clearing an area in our local area from unwanted litter!



Art

We will use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop our ideas and use a wide range of techniques (colour, pattern, texture) to create artwork from recycled materials to educate the community about littering.

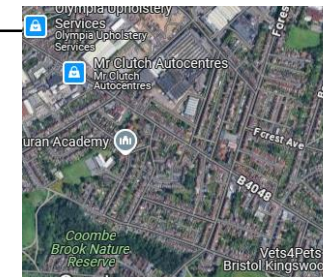
Owl Class – Term 3

Geography

We will briefly recap key physical features (forest, hill, soil, river, valley, vegetation) and human features (city, town, house and shop).

We will also use simple compass directions (north, south, east and west) and locational and directional language (near and far, left and right) to describe physical and human features on a map.

We will use aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features; devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key. We will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.



PSHE

This term our Jigsaw Unit it called 'Dreams and Goals'. We will think about choosing realistic goals and how to persevere when tasks become challenging. The children will end the term by working as a group towards a common goal.

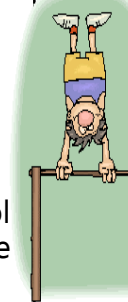


Computing

In Computing this term we will be learning about programming.. The children will learn how to use instructions to create different algorithms to program a floor robot.

PE
