

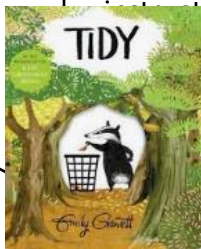
Brilliant Beginning:

Something has happened to our classroom! We will become detectives to work out what has happened and who is responsible. We will use all of our learning this term to help spread positive messages about our environment.



English

The first piece of writing the children will be working towards is a Finding Narrative where the children will be discovering a mysterious creature! We will then move on to writing a set of instructions to explain how to catch this creature.



Maths

This term, we will be continuing to learn about multiplication. We will be building on our learning and start to think about how we can answer a variety of multiplication problems. These will mostly be linked to the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Fantastic Finale:

We will educate the community of the importance of recycling and looking after our environment. We will do this by sharing information posters. We will also be clearing an area in our local area from unwanted litter!



Art

We will use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop our ideas and use a wide range of techniques (colour, pattern, texture) to create artwork from recycled materials to educate the community about littering.

Geography

We will briefly recap key physical features (forest, hill, soil, river, valley, vegetation) and human features (city, town, house and shop).

We will also use simple compass directions (north, south, east and west) and locational and directional language (near and far, left and right) to describe physical and human features on a map.

We will use aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features; devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key. We will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.



PSHE

This term our Jigsaw Unit is called 'Dreams and Goals'. We will think about choosing realistic goals and how to persevere when tasks become challenging. The children will end the term by working as a group towards a common goal.

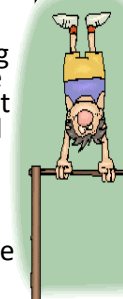


Computing

In Computing this term we will be using iPads to take digital photos of litter and recycled objects.

PE

In PE this term we will be learning Gymnastics and Yoga. We will be learning about a range of different yoga poses and using control and balance to perform these poses. Please can you send your child in with leggings or shorts every Tuesday or for Health and Safety reasons they will not be able to use the equipment.



RE

In RE this term we will be looking at the key question 'Who is God to Sikhs?'. We will be learning about the life and teachings of Guru Nanak, the importance of the Guru Granth Sahib and three most important Sikhi beliefs.

In music this term we will be creating a musical story. Singing and listening are at the heart of each lesson. Key question: How Does Music Make the World a Better Place?
