

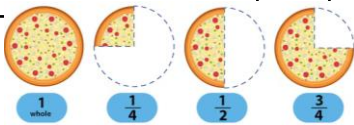
Brilliant Beginning:

We will design and build our very own moving toy — using levers, axles and wheels, or even a pneumatic system!

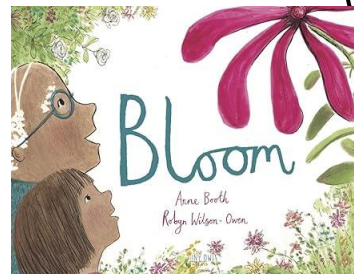
This amazing invention will go right at the end of the timeline, showing what toys look like today.

History

We will be creating a timeline using our knowledge of how materials and technology have changed to help us order toys correctly. We will learn about the life of a famous toy inventor and their contribution to the world.

PSHE

Using our PSHE scheme, Jigsaw we will be thinking about how we and our bodies change as we get older using the correct names for parts of the body. We will also explore life cycles of all animals to show how everything changes as it gets older.



Computing

In Computing this term, we will be exploring how music can make you think and feel. We will be using digital tools to create different rhythms and tunes.

PE
