

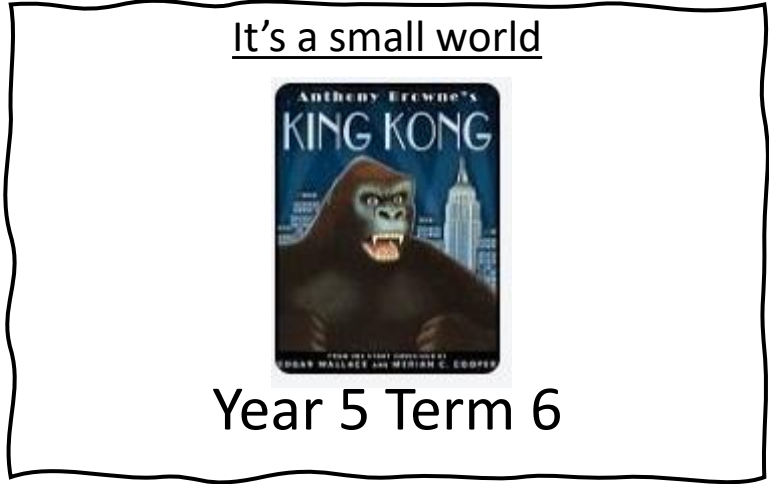
**Brilliant Beginning:**  
We will go on a virtual tour of New York City.

**English**  
'King Kong' is our example text that we will focus on this term. This includes constructing a dilemma narrative and writing a balanced argument.

**Maths**  
In Maths, we will continue working with fractions, focusing on finding fractions of amounts and using a part to determine the whole.

**Fantastic Finale:**  
We will make a poster comparing Bristol and New York.

**Geography Focus**  
In Topic, children will explore the similarities between Bristol and New York. They explore the use of maps and understand the symbols and features of a map. They will also look at and compare the physical and human geography of the two areas.



**Science Focus**  
In Science, we will be looking at animals and plants in their habitats. We will also look at their life cycles and how some plants and animals reproduce.

**PSHE**  
Our focus is 'Changing Me' where we will be looking at the changes we go through as we get older.

**Languages**  
We will be focusing on the French words for time and part of the day.

**RE**  
In RE, our key question will be 'What is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God?'

**Computing**  
In this unit, pupils develop their knowledge of selection by revisiting how conditions can be used in programs and then learning how the If... Then... Else structure can be used to select different outcomes depending on whether a condition is true or false.

**PE**  
PE will be completely outdoors next term. We will be taking part in Rounders and Athletics.

**Music**  
In Term 6, we will be listening to a range of music, performing, improvising, and composing, while building our understanding of musical elements and styles.
