The free, annual programme challenges children, aged 0 to 12, to read up to six library books of their choice over the summer. This includes fiction, non-fiction, ebooks, audiobooks, poetry, joke books, comics or anime.

Starting on **Saturday 4 July 2026**, children who take part in the challenge can collect fun stickers and a bookmark. Once participants complete the challenge, they will receive a medal and a certificate at their local library.

To take part, children can sign up at their nearest library, where they will be given a collector folder to keep a record of their Summer Reading Challenge journey. The Summer Reading Challenge website also offers book recommendations, quizzes, competitions, author interviews, and activities for all ages, plus resources for parents, carers, and teachers.

There are a host of fun events and activities planned at Bristol libraries for families over the summer to celebrate the programme, including children's storytelling sessions and arts and crafts activities.
