Nail & Footwear Expectations

To help keep all children safe and able to participate fully in school activities, we ask that children do not wear long acrylic nails, nail extensions, or excessively long nails to school.

Why is this important?

- **Safety:** Long, rigid, or artificial nails can easily crack, break, or scratch during play and physical activities, potentially causing injury to the child wearing them or to others.
- **Learning and participation:** Acrylic nails and long nails can make it more difficult for children to fully engage in everyday classroom activities such as writing, using equipment, practical tasks, art activities, and computing.
- **Hygiene:** Short, clean nails are easier to keep hygienic and support good handwashing practices.

We would also like to remind families that children should wear sensible, secure footwear to school.

Footwear should:

- Be comfortable and fit securely on the foot.
- Allow children to move safely around the school, including running and playing at breaktimes.
- Be suitable for PE activities, outdoor learning, and emergency evacuations.

Please avoid footwear such as high heels, platform shoes, backless sandals, sliders, flip-flops, crocs or shoes with large heels, as these can present a safety risk and may limit children's ability to participate fully in school activities. Thank you.
