Welcome back! This is a short and yet exciting term.

The children have settled back really well and it has been lovely to see them in assembly this week. Over the next two terms, each year group gets ready to transition to the next school year. Our reception children will be getting ready to be part of Key Stage 1. Our Year 1 pupils will be completing their phonics checks and getting ready to be the oldest pupils in the infant school. The Year 2 pupils are getting ready to transition into the junior school. Our Year 3 had their first swimming session this week and have really enjoyed their first dip in the pool - this will continue into Year 4. The Year 4 pupils are getting ready to move upstairs on the junior site and our Year 5 are almost ready to be the oldest pupils in the school as they join Year 6. Finally, our Year 6 pupils will be leaving us in a few months as they move on to secondary school.

We will also be preparing to welcome our new Reception to school. This will involve the school visiting nurseries and some stay and play sessions. *Speak out. Stay safe.* is a programme for children aged 5-11 which aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or Childline.

This child friendly programme is aligned with the curriculum and consists of age appropriate virtual assemblies and supporting classroom based activities which we have reviewed.
