

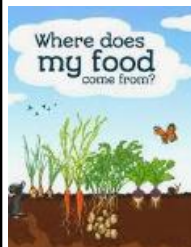
## Brilliant Beginning:

## Understanding the world

We will be learning about where our food comes from and grow our own food, investigating the best conditions for growth. We will keep a diary as we observe our seeds grow. We will talk about different environments as we explore the illustrations in the book 'The Train Ride.'

In reading, we begin phase 4 as we learn to read more longer words, especially focusing on words ending -ing, -ed and -es. There will be new tricky words too. In writing, we will be developing our sentences and having a go at practicing our skills with greater independence.

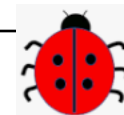
## Mathematics

This term, we will be looking at patterns within numbers beyond 10. We will continue to develop our confidence to recall our number bonds and secure our understanding of more and fewer by adding and taking away. We will explore ideas including doubling, halving and sharing.



## Expressive arts and design

We will use a range of techniques to create images of animals including printing, collage and painting. We will experiment with a range of painting tools including different brush sizes, mix colours, and combine materials that have been cut, torn and glued to add textures to a picture.
