Using the process of design, make, evaluate we will be creating our own Castle fit for a King or Queen. We will explore different structures and test how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable.

We will design purposeful, functional, appealing products based on design criteria. We will select from and use a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks [for example, cutting, shaping, joining and finishing].

PSHE

Using our PSHE scheme, Jigsaw we will be thinking about relationships. We will be thinking about our families and friends and who we can trust. We will also look at how we can celebrate our special relationships safely.

RE

In RE this term we will be looking at the key question How important is the Qur'an to Muslims. We will look at what the Qur'an tells Muslims about how they should be living their lives and how they show respect to the holy book as well.



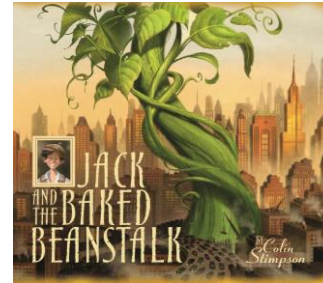
English

Computing

In Computing this term we will be learning about data and information, We will be looking at how this can be collected, organized and presented. We will be presenting data in a variety of different ways.

Maths

This term we will be looking at measurement, statistics and money.

We will be looking at length and height which covers units of measure.

In statistics we will focus on tally charts, tables, block diagrams and pictograms.

When we cover money we will recognise coins and notes. We will compare different amounts, calculate with money and find change.

Fantastic Finale:

We will design and make a castle using selected materials for the job! We will use these castle to help tell our own version of Jack and the Beanstalk.



Science

In order to help our special fairytale character we need to develop our knowledge of materials and their properties. As scientists, we will be carrying out tests on different materials and using our observations to answer questions such as which is the strongest or most waterproof.



PE

In PE this term we will be learning about sending and receiving, striking and fielding. We will be improving our ball skills and ability to work as a team towards a common goal.



Music

In music this term we will be exploring improvisation through singing. We will be introducing the children to a range of musical terminology such as tempo, pitch and a basic understanding of musical notes. We will also be asking the question 'How does music make us happy?'
