English

This term we will be exploring the wonderful book 'Jack and the Baked Beanstalk'. The children will be writing a persuasive letter to Jack and working towards a twisted narrative where they put their own spin on a traditional tale. Building up to writing this narrative the children will practice using noun phrases, time adverbials and alliteration.

Maths

This term we begin by consolidating our addition and subtraction strategies for two-digit numbers before moving on to learning about money, including the denominations and value of the different coins and notes. We will be adding different amounts and giving change. As the term progresses, we will be learning about fractions and looking at multiplication and division in more detail.



Fantastic Finale:

Fox and Otter Classes will make their own ladders and use these as they turn into story tellers and tell their own version of Jack and the Beanstalk.

DT

After investigating materials in Science, we will use our findings to design, build and evaluate a structure for our special character. As well as deciding on a suitable material, we will explore different methods of construction and structure shape.

PSHE

Science

RE

In RE this term, we will be looking at the key question How important is the Qur'an to Muslims. We will look at what the Qur'an tells Muslims about how they should be living their lives and how they show respect to the holy book as well.

Computing

In Computing this term, we will be learning about data and information, We will be looking at how this can be collected, organized and presented. We will be presenting data in a variety of different ways.

PE
