This term, we will be writing an environmental change narrative, focusing on sharing character emotion and creating atmosphere.

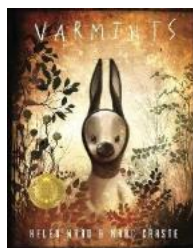


## Maths
